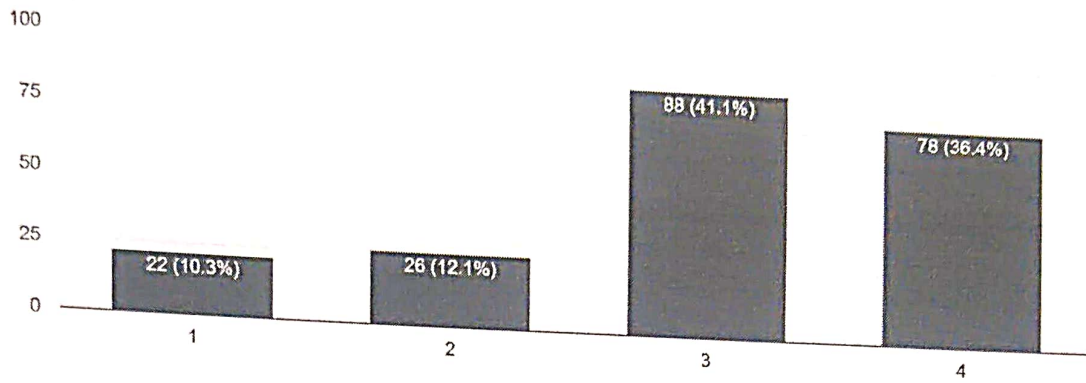

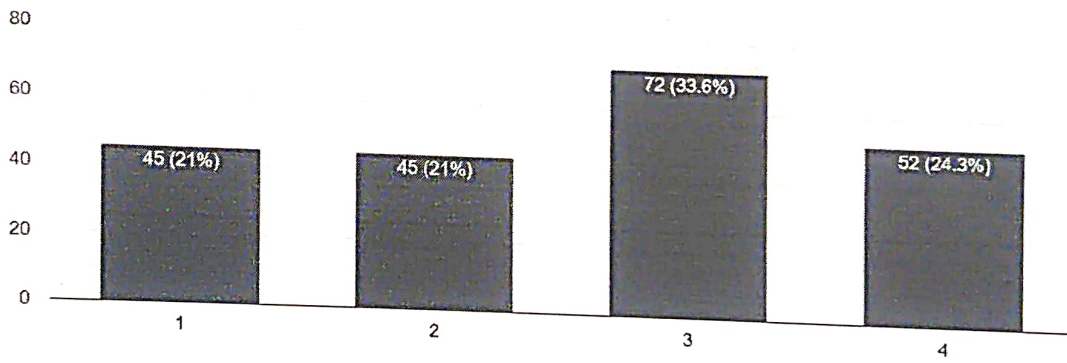
2. Rate the level of " Student-teacher interaction" in the Institute

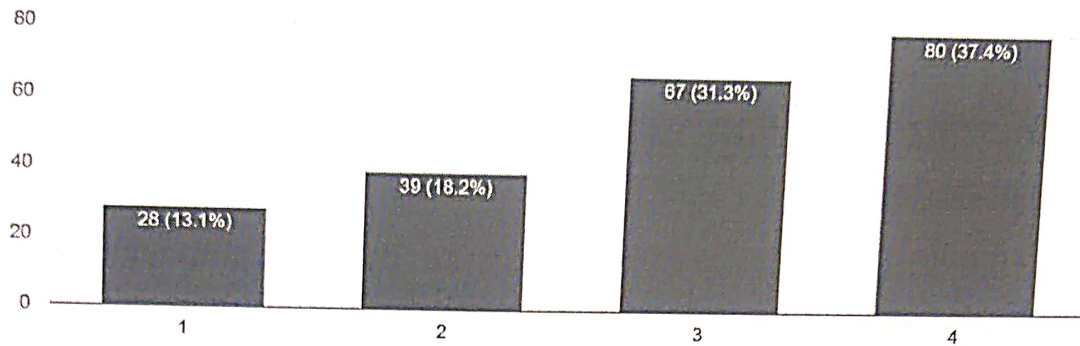

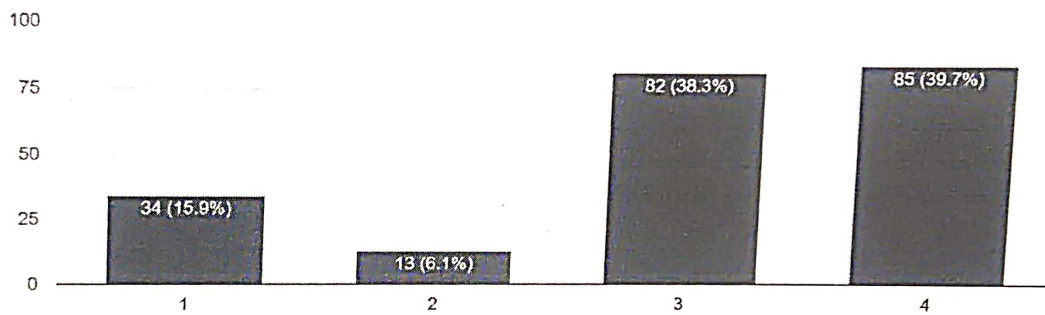

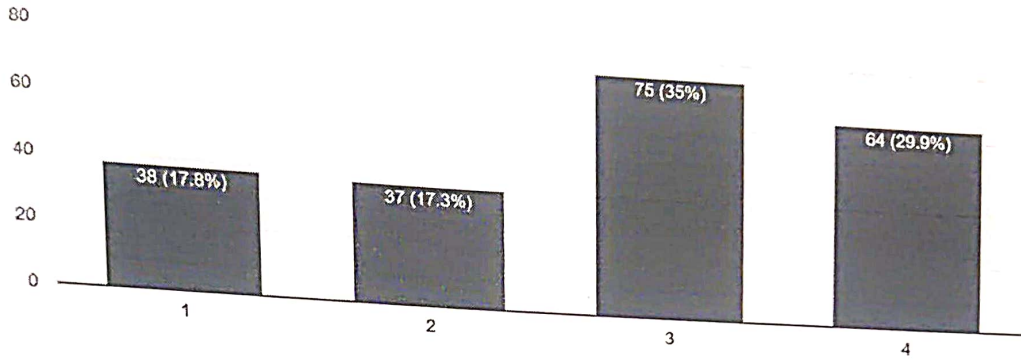

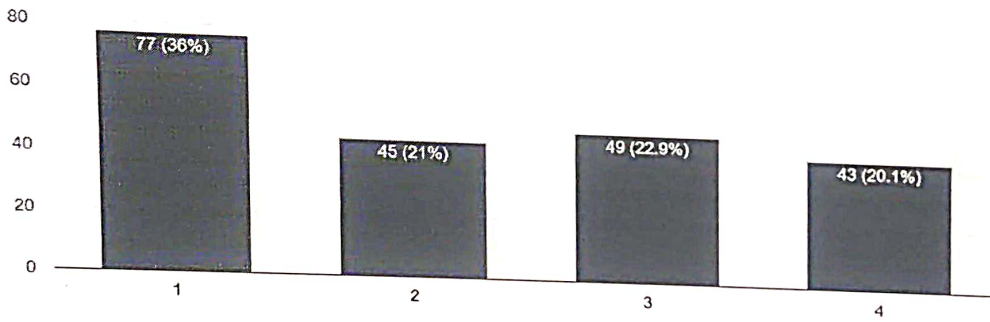

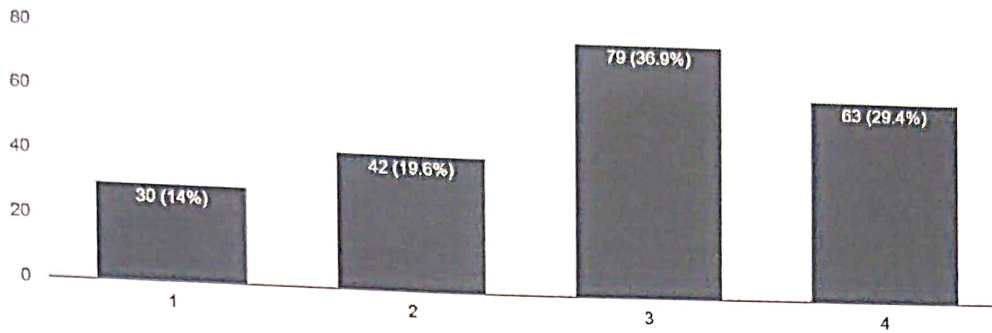

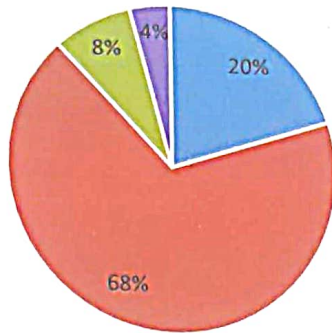

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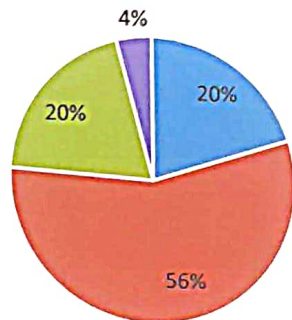
Rating the overall development of the ward

Satisfaction with the students' discipline of the Institute

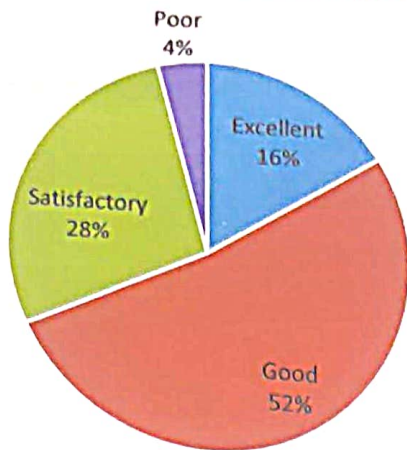

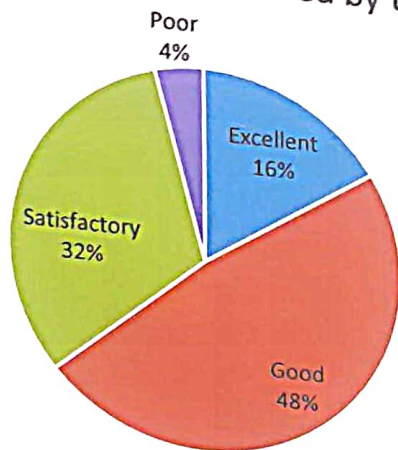
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Satisfaction with the Administration of Institute

Sl. No.	Suggestions Given	Action Taken
1	More no of entrepreneurship and career guiding program should be organised	Commerce Department and Economics Department are requested to organise such program.
2	Study tour and field exposure must be organised	All heads of the department are requested to organise such programmes. By this time the students of Botany Department has visited IISER, Berhampur and Department of Zoology Proposed to visit Zoological Survey of India, Gopalpur very shortly. Similarly other departments are also planning to visit for exposure.
3	Recruitment of more number of guest faculties	For the session 2024-25 eighteen number of guest faculties was engaged.
4	Continuous evaluation process must be adapted	This is adopted under NEP with effect from 2024-25.
5	More number of classrooms and smart class rooms must be constructed.	This year 6 number of smart class rooms constructed.
6	More number of sweepers must be recruited to ensure campus cleanliness. Waste management system like vermicomposting should be done.	Another sweeper has been engaged under outsourcing method. Planning is going on for waste management that includes vermicomposting also.
